# Preliminary Analysis



- Impact Analysis still ongoing, this is only preliminary information
- In general it is possible to implement such policy change in the existing policy and procedure framework
- Only reports are valid where the suspected hijacker is bound by the RIPE Policies (aka using resources issued by the RIPE NCC)
- BGP hijack policy violation will not be combined with other reasons for termination or de-registration
- Single hijacking of resources (confirmed as deliberate hijack) will not lead to termination of the SSA and/or de-registration

# Preliminary Analysis



- RIPE NCC will only administer the process
- Evaluation and decision will be done by external group of experts
- Quantity and quality of this pool of experts will be crucial
  - Theoretically 1-2 valid reports per day possible (based on [bgpstream.com](http://bgpstream.com) data)
  - Challenges to identify deliberate vs accidental hijacks
  - Time constrains and liability
  - Will put to a test the capability of the RIPE community to self-regulation
